A five-line poem, consisting of a set number of words, is called a "cinquain." Here is an example:

Puppy,
Happy, silly
Chewing, jumping, yapping
Playful bundle of energy
Beagle

	This outline will help you create your first cinquain about an animal:
*	Line 1: One NOUN which tells what animal your poem is about.
*	Line 2: Two ADJECTIVES that describe the animal you are writing about:
*	Line 3: Three VERBS that describe the animal's actions:
*	Line 4: Four words that make a PHRASE that describes the animal
*	Line 5: One SYNONYM for the word in line 1

Your poem is complete!

You can write cinquains about other animals, people, places, and things, too! These poems are fun to write, to read, and to share with your family and friends.
