Pet Dog Training 201

Intermediate training isn't for everyone. But, if you want your dog to have a broader "vocabulary" and more refined skills, or if you and your dog just love training, Pet Dog Training 201 *is* for you!

With the aid of our instructors, you will help your dog to become more reliable and respond to commands more readily. An introduction to off-lead training is part of the course. This class also continues the tradition of other Anti-Cruelty Society training classes: non-harsh handling, problem solving and strengthening the bond between you and your dog.

To successfully achieve the desired results of Pet Dog Training 201, we ask that prior to attending the class, your dog be able to master the following commands: Automatic or non-placement Sit, Down on verbal command, 3 minute Down/Stay, 1 minute Sit/Stay, controlled walking on a leash, Come, and "Leave It". Of course, your dog should not exhibit aggressive behavior towards other dogs or towards people.

The 8-week Pet Dog Training 201 class is open to all spayed or neutered (this is **required**) dogs that have successfully completed a beginner training class. A copy of a graduation certificate or letter from your instructor must accompany your registration form along with proof of spay/neuter and current inoculations (Distemper a.k.a.DHLPP and Rabies). Handlers must be at least 14 years of age; handlers under 18 years must be accompanied by an adult. Children under five years can not attend the classes.

The donation is \$125 for non-ACS adopters and \$100 for shelter or rescue-adopted dogs and Puppy Pre-school and/or Pet Dog Training 101 graduates. This fee must be paid at the time of registration; **it is non-refundable**. We will return your check if classes are full. There is no additional fee for second handlers or other family members who attend the same session. (There is a \$50 deposit required of ACS employees and volunteers who have finished their probationary period, and returning students, which is reimbursable upon *successful completion* of the class. There is a charge for the training equipment.)

The class fee includes a light line, 30-foot leash, and educational materials. Students must provide their own 6-foot leash (no chain or retractable leashes) and training collar ("choke" chains are *not* used in this class). Training collars will be available for purchase.

Class size is limited to the **first ten paid applicants**. Classes fill up quickly. Your receipt of these materials does not guarantee your enrollment in class.
